PERSONAL STATEMENT

I have decided to embark on a research career because I strongly believe in the value of reading, writing, analyzing, and sharing valuable information to improve the life of people. Indeed, research is instrumental in building and improving knowledge, as well as in facilitating learning. Undoubtedly, having a mind opened to research is crucial to finding new possible cures, to preventing diseases as well as to offering the best for our patients. I am a Medical Doctor and a Paediatrician, qualified as a Paediatric Gastroenterologist and actually working as Assistant Professor in Pediatric Gastroenterology at Sapienza – University of Rome. During my training, I have visited and collaborated with different US centers for Pediatric Inflammatory Bowel Diseases and Eosinophilic Esophagitis in which I appreciated the scientific way of working on pediatric research. I have obtained a Ph.D. in pediatric gastroenterology focusing on the gut immunological and microbial features characterizing pediatric inflammatory bowel disease in 2018. In this period, I have extensively studied the disease mechanisms of pediatric IBD with translational research (including genetic, immunological and gut microbiota interactions) and I'm currently leading the research field of pan-enteric capsule endoscopy in Crohn's disease. As a result of my experience, I am aware of the importance of translational research and international cooperation between referral centers as the best way to improve knowledge and develop new therapeutic strategies for our patients. I have carried out several studies and successfully administered projects collaborated with other researchers and produced several peer-reviewed publications. I published during the last 10 years over than 70 manuscripts and book chapters in international peer-reviewed journals indexed in Pubmed/Medline and/or Scopus/ISI, especially in the field of Paediatrics, Gastroenterology and Gastrointestinal Endoscopy. I have been invited to revise papers for a number of journals from my fields. As a Research Assistant, I participated in training and lecturing medical students and Masters trainees at the Medical School of Sapienza – University of Rome.

I'm a member of the European Society of Pediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition (ESPGHAN), and I'm currently involved in several working groups: Endoscopy Working Group, Eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorders WG (EGIDs), and in the IBD Interest Group. I'm currently coordinating the European Prospective Pediatric Registry of Eosinophilic Esophagitis (PEER registry) on behalf of ESPGHAN. I have coordinated as the lead author the position paper on the use of Endoscopy in Pediatric Inflammatory Bowel Disease on behalf of ESPGHAN. I have also received a research grant from the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ASGE) to conduct a multicenter project on the use of a new model of pan-enteric capsule endoscopy in monitoring pediatric IBD. I have built a national center for Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE) and eosinophilic gastrointestinal disorders (EGIDs) in the Sapienza - University of Rome. In this center, we also have good communication and relationships with patient advocacy groups, which help us organize meetings to improve awareness on EGIDs in school and the workplace. My ultimate goal is to build a bridge between Europe and USA in the field of pediatric research, broadening minds, as well as sharing different points of views.
